NEW AWARD PAY GUIDES

A reminder that Fair Work Commission announced an increase of 3.5% to the National Minimum Wage and minimum award wages effective from 1 July 2025. Any workers who are covered by a modern award and are paid the minimum award rates based on their classification, need to be reviewed to ensure that your meeting the minimum responsibilities and payroll obligations.


